



Scholarship Application for 2019 Summer Camps

We believe that a camp experience is beneficial to the development of all youth. We also believe that no child should miss this experience for financial reasons. To help make this a reality, we intentionally set camp rates as affordable as possible, and we offer additional financial assistance through income-based scholarships. The Saginaw YMCA’s Annual Campaign, funded by generous gifts of individuals, community partners, and corporations, provides for these camp scholarships.

The following chart identifies the percentage of the camp registration fee that is supported through camp scholarships for each income level. If your total household income qualifies your camper for a partial scholarship, please provide the following for consideration:

- Completed Scholarship Application
- Proof of Income (IRS 1040)
- Minimum \$50 deposit per camper

Scholarships are offered for **one session per child each summer** and cannot be used with any other discounts. Specialty camps are not eligible for financial assistance towards the \$100 added fee.

The deadline for all applications is May 1, 2019. Due to the heavy volume of applications and limited funding, we may not be able to accept applications postmarked after the deadline.

Please mail all forms to the address listed above, or drop these off at the Membership Service Desk at the YMCA of Saginaw, ATTN: Camp Timbers Enrollment Specialist.

Once your application is received, our Enrollment Specialist will contact you by phone to verify your total camp costs. At this time, with your approval, your camper will be registered for the camp session of your choice. At that time, if you choose not to register your child for camp your original \$50 deposit will be refunded. Once your child is registered, the \$50 deposit is non-refundable.

Following registration, we will share any additional forms and resources needed prior to the start of camp, such as camper health forms, liability waivers, packing lists, and more.
