



Scholarship Application for 2021 Summer Camps

Thank you for your interest in YMCA Camp Timbers for your child. It would be a pleasure to partner with you to make a summer camp experience possible in 2021.

As much as we try to keep camp affordable, the cost of meals, lodging, activities, and staff for a full camp session does add up. Thankfully, we have income-based scholarships available to help ensure no child misses out on camp for financial reasons. The Saginaw YMCA's Annual Campaign and the generous gifts of individuals, community partners, and businesses make these scholarships possible.

To apply for a scholarship:

1. Use the chart below to find **the percentage you'll pay**, based on the **Tier A** rate. The remaining cost of camp is supported by scholarship funds donated by individuals, businesses, or organizations.
2. Please complete the attached "Household Application" as a way to report your income. This form allows camp to receive partial funding for the meals we serve and helps us spread our scholarship dollars to help more campers. If you choose to not use the "Household Application," please e-mail Timbers@SaginawYMCA.org to request an alternate form to submit with your scholarship request.

4. After reviewing your forms we'll call to confirm the scholarship. At that time, a **\$50 non-refundable deposit** is due for each camper to complete their registration. You may send a deposit check with your forms, or pay by credit card on the phone. The remaining balance is due by June 1st, 2021.

This doesn't include specialty camp programs, horse rides, or camp store purchases. These may be added, but are not eligible for scholarship support. Discounts, including multi-child savings or member savings, are not available with scholarships.

Scholarships are available as funding allows. We encourage families to apply as soon as possible due to the number of requests we receive. The deadline for scholarship applications is June 1, 2021.

A \$50 non-refundable deposit for each camper is due at the time of registration. This can be transferred to another camper or session in 2021 only. The balance is due by June 1, 2021.
